Item to support the Transgender and Drag Expressive Communities:

- Gender affirming and drag clothing
- Costume Jewelry
- New Cosmetics (eye shadow, eye liner, lipstick, blush, foundation (in darker tones)
- Wigs
- high heels

Items to help school aged children:

- Writing implements: pens, pencils, pencil crayons, crayons, felt pens, dry erase markers
- Rulers
- Erasers
- Scissors
- Stickers (all kinds, these are very loved)
- Embroidery Thread (for making bracelets)
- Safety pins (larger size)
- Basketballs & Soccer balls (pump to blow them up)
- Children's t-shirts in various sizes
- Toothbrushes (various sizes for children and adults, we can buy toothpaste there)
- Stuffed animals, smaller sizes, good quality
- Educational toys (counting game, color games, wooden puzzles, with no English words) for age 3 plus.

- First aid kit for the school

Over-the-Counter Medicines are greatly needed:

- Bandages and band-aids (all sizes) and any first aid equipment
- gauze, tape, butterfly dressings, etc.
- Pain relief medicine such as Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Tylenol, NSAIDs (Motrin, Aleve)
- Anti-nausea/anti-vomiting medications
- Multi-vitamins - infant, child and adult, especially pre-natal
- Other vitamins and minerals, particularly B6, D, C and E, Zinc
- Digital thermometers (centigrade)
